Restrictions:	<i>No restrictions on number of guests</i>	<p>A combo ceremony is a ceremony that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> includes the naming of two or more children who are not siblings, or incorporates another type of ceremony (namings are generally incorporated as part of a wedding or reaffirmation of vows ceremony) or follows close on or is closely followed by a second but related ceremony (usually within hours but possibly involving a change of venue) <p>Because of the complexity and work required to develop and officiate at a combo ceremony an additional fee will apply</p>	<p>Naming ceremonies are not "one size fits all". Different clients have different needs, so I offer a choice of broad service options, with differing fees and inclusions.</p> <p>My fees for conducting your child's naming ceremony are based on a number of criteria in order to provide you with options that will match your needs and your budget.</p> <p>Because different options require differing levels of input, time and energy required to create and perform your ceremony for you, my fees reflect the size and complexity of your ceremony as impacted by a combination of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Type/Complexity of Ceremony All of my ceremonies are custom-created. I do not expect you to choose from pre-written components for any service level.. Time required to develop the ceremony Developing a custom-created ceremony that reflects your family takes time. The more complex the ceremony the more time it takes. I write a first draft based on information I gather from you and you have full rights of editing. Going through the process with one or more drafts takes time. Numbers of Certificates Production of personalised certificate takes time as well as materials. My charges therefore are adjusted where additional certificates are required. Location of Ceremony I build travelling into my fee structure. Travel beyond 100km return (which covers Brisbane City, Ipswich, Logan Shire, Pine Rivers, Redcliffe and Redlands) attracts an additional fee.
