Explaining My Fees

Reaffirmation of vows ceremonies are not “one size fits all”. Different clients have different needs, so I offer a range of options, with differing fees and inclusions. My fees for conducting your ceremony are based on a number of criteria in order to provide you with options that will match your needs and your budget. Because different options require differing levels of input, time and energy required to develop, create and perform your ceremony for you my fees reflect the size and complexity of your ceremony as impacted by a combination of the following:

- the size of the ceremony
- type/complexity of the ceremony
- time required to develop the ceremony
- whether a rehearsal is required
- the day of the week on which the ceremony is held
- the location of the ceremony:

1. Type/Complexity of Ceremony

I custom-create each ceremony for an individual couple. I do not expect you to choose from pre-written ceremonies or components. However, there is a world of difference between a fairly simple reaffirmation of vows and what is essentially a “do-over” wedding – often chosen by those who have married in a quiet ceremony and now want to celebrate their marriage with family and friends with a reaffirmation of vows ceremony that includes all the elements of a large white wedding – processional, wedding party, etc.

2. Time required to develop the ceremony

Developing a custom-created ceremony that reflects your personalities, styles and wishes takes time. The more complex the ceremony the more time it takes. I write a first draft based on information I gather from you and you have full rights of editing. Going through the process with one or more drafts also takes time.

3. Rehearsal

A full service couture ceremony (i.e. a ‘do-over’ wedding with a processional and recessional needs a rehearsal, as do complex rituals. Readers also need to be rehearsed. A rehearsal is built in to the full-service couture ceremony fee structure but I am happy to add a full onsite rehearsal to any of the other levels of service (add \$100 to the fee). If the ceremony site is more than 100 km return trip from my office you will also need to double the excess travel fee.

4. Location of Ceremony

I build travelling into my fee structure. Travel beyond 100 km return (which covers Brisbane City, Ipswich, Logan Shire, Pine Rivers, Redcliffe and Redlands) attracts an additional fee.

The Bottom Line

When comparing the costs of celebrant services it is important that you have an accurate picture. **Because I offer a range of service levels you will never need to pay for services you don't use, and because I come to you for all meetings you won't need to add the hidden cost of travel to your ceremony cost.**

Always establish exactly what the quoted fee includes and whether there will be additional charges for services such as a rehearsal.

- there may be undisclosed and/hidden costs.
- there may be hidden costs, for example if the celebrant expects you to travel to his/her office for meetings these costs can add up

Combo Reaffirmation of Vows Ceremony

A combo commitment ceremony is a reaffirmation of vows that

- incorporates another type of ceremony, or
- includes more than one couple (double or ceremony), or
- Follows close on or is closely followed by a second but related ceremony (usually within hours but possibly involving a change of venue)

Because of the complexity and work required to develop and officiate at a combo ceremony an additional fee applies. This will typically be the full fee for the wedding plus 50% of the fee for the second type of ceremony.
